







# **ALERT: HIGH FIRE DANGER PROMPTS EARLY BURNING PERMIT REQUIREMENT**

**“Citizens are required to obtain a burning permit from the Tennessee Department of Agriculture Division of Forestry before conducting any outdoor, open burning of debris within 500 feet of woodlands, grasslands or forestlands. This remains in effect through May 15.”**
